The NCLL encourages all teams to travel together. Please drive safely and responsibly as a guest and representative of the NCLL and your host institution. **Due to security and limited parking on site, the NCLL will provide buses from the Navy-Marine Corps Stadium during Saturday May 7 ONLY.** The stadium is located at 550 Taylor Ave, Annapolis, MD 21401 and there is a fee to park (private company). The NCLL will provide buses to the fields all day Saturday May 7 from 7:45 am to 30 minutes after last game as fans and spectators may use the trolley as well to downtown Annapolis (trolley may be an additional fee to use):

United State Naval Academy Guidelines

The United States Naval Academy is the host of the 2022 National Tournament. Guests are asked to obey local driving limits as well as be responsible for any clean-up. Please provide ample time for transportation within the campus area as all games will begin on time. In case of inclement weather, the Tournament Director will update via Instagram (@NCLLAX), Twitter @NCLLax and online at www.ncllax.com as well as through each team representative. All teams are requested to check in upon arrival once on the grounds of the United States Naval Academy. All spectators are encouraged to watch safely on either sideline. Please refrain from standing near corners of the field, behind the goal or along the team benches. Teams that congregate in a group are asked to do so away from field of play and to secure all belongings. The NCLL, Navy, its' staff and employees are not responsible for loss of equipment or other items. PLEASE BE AWARE THAT ALL TEAM PERSONNEL, STAFF AND SUPPORTING FANS WILL NEED AN ID AS NAVY (AS A FEDERAL INSTITUTION) ACCESS MAY ONLY BE GAINED WITH APPROPRIATE ISSUED IDENTIFICATIONS. SEE ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR DETAILS.

-- State driver's licenses from Minnesota, Illinois, Missouri, New Mexico or Washington and identification cards from American Samoa are non-compliant with the Real ID Act.

-- Until further notice, individuals presenting credentials from the above states and territory must provide a second form of identification, and in many cases IT MUST INCLUDE A PHOTO.

-- Individuals who provide driver's licenses from states that do not meet Real ID Act requirements must provide an additional approved form of ID listed in table 12-1 of CNICINST 5530.14a, Ashore Protection Program. The table is attached.

Hotels

Annapolis has several accommodations in all price ranges and depending on your stay securing lodging within a 30-minute radius will provide multiple selections, such as BWI, Hanover (MD), Baltimore and Washington DC as well as Annapolis, MD.

Benches

Team benches will be marked accordingly and all spectators are asked to stay away from end lines and corners for safety. Officials and event staff reserve the right to keep all areas safe before, during and after competition. The facility will have open restrooms at each field.

Team bench area will be supplied with the following:

- Seating for twenty (20) people
- One (1) 8-foot scorer's table/2 chairs
- Ice
- Water
- Sponsored products (water bottles, cups, etc)
- Trainer will be on each field.

Sideline Security

Securing the sidelines and insuring that only authorized personnel have access to the field area and team areas will be a priority for the NCLL and host staff. Event staff will be stationed at the entrances to the field areas. Only properly credentialed staff and properly dressed team members will be allowed in the team areas. Anyone without proper credentials or team dress will be asked or escorted off of the field. All fans are expected to follow the Rules of Sportsmanship and respect all opponents, staff, officials and other spectators.

Student-Athlete Identification and Procedures

The NCLL will check ALL student-athletes identification cards before Elite 8 and then randomly, the NCLL will check ID cards during games. All teams have submitted their official roster and players must have their student ID and state license with them to participate. At any time, the NCLL reserves the right to deny access to the tournament if a student-athlete does not comply and also may subject their team to expulsion from tournament as well as possible suspension from the league.

Medical

The NCLL will provide an Athletic Trainer for teams and officials on each field.

Team Locker Room

There will be extremely limited access to any changing areas. The NCLL recommends that all players come dressed for the event. Each field will have access to restrooms only. Water will be provided on each bench.

Uniforms

Please make sure to have all players appropriately dressed for competition as well as have both sets of jerseys on hand.

Procedures

1. The National Championships are a single elimination tournament.
2. There will be no vendors on site.
3. There is no live-streaming available as the NCLL will use Twitter in game for score updates as well as use Instagram during and after the tournament.
4. As an NCAA institution, Navy is a no alcohol and no tobacco campus.
5. All teams must check in on the day of the event. The NCLL will check everyone's ID against the team's official roster to verify players. At any time, the Tournament Director retains the right to withhold any player and/or team from participating if any information does not match.
6. Please make sure to provide ample time for travel. All games will begin on time.

NCLL RULES

Please review the 2022 NCAA rule book as NCLL rules will be in force during the National Tournament.

NCLL Rules are modified 2022 NCAA Rules with the exceptions below.

Quarters	Four - 20 minute running periods except for stop/start for penalties. Clock will be stop/start with under 3:00 in 4 th quarter regardless of score.
Clearing	Teams have 20 seconds to advance past midline.
Stick Checks	Each team receives one stick check and keeps the stick check if the stick is illegal. If stick is legal, the team cannot use a stick check again. Stick checks can be called during stoppage of play at any time and all officials may check any stick they deem to be illegal during gameplay but not before or after game for penalty purposes.
Penalty Time	Stop/start
Dive	No diving.
Modified Shot Clock	Officials announce "timer on": 20 seconds to create a shot.
Timeouts	2 per half as per NCAA : in offensive third of field.
All other 2022 NCAA rules apply in absence of above mentioned rules.	

It is expected that all coaches, players and staff will have detailed knowledge of said rules and if needed, ask the Head Referee or Tournament Director for questions concerning rule interpretation and procedures. All at times, the coaches and teams must stay on their sideline and away from field of play unless in competition as well as exhibit good sportsmanship towards opponents, fans, officials and staff.
